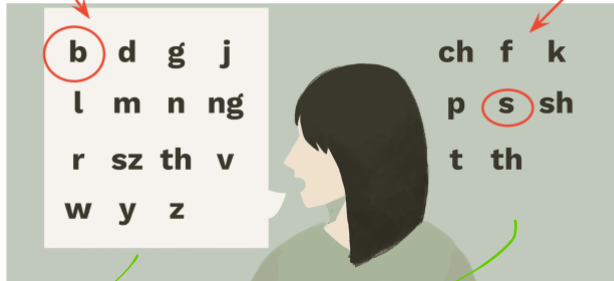
voiced = vibration throat
